### **Contract Action**


Today's board action will provide approval of the **B Branch Station Consolidation** Project to make **accessibility** and station improvements to benefit riders of the Green Line



# **Construction Scope of Work**

Consolidate four (4) existing Green Line stations on the B Branch along Commonwealth Avenue adjacent to Boston University, into two (2), fully accessible, brand new stations

- The four (4) existing stations to be consolidated are Babcock Street with Pleasant Street and St Paul Street with BU West.
- The two (2) new stations will have:
  - Equal passenger capacity as the four (4) existing stations
  - Longer platforms of 225 feet (to accommodate new Type 10 Supercar)
  - 150 feet of canopies at each platform
  - Accessible walkways
  - Upgraded communications and safety/security systems
  - New lighting, signage, benches and other station elements



### **Construction Overview**

Service Impact	<ul> <li>B Branch: September 2020 – October 2021</li> <li>Weeknights starting at 9:00 PM and Weekends (Sat-Sun)</li> <li>Existing stations will be open to the public during weekdays (5AM - 8PM) throughout construction</li> </ul>
ternative Service	Shuttle buses to enhance Route 55 between Babcock St and Kenmore to meet needs during nights and weekends

# **Outreach and Coordination**

- Operational impacts are anticipated during the construction of the project
- Alternative service will be provided with shuttle buses on weeknights and weekends
- Coordination has been on-going with Green Line Operations, MBTA Customer Experience, the City of Boston Transportation Department (BTD), MassDOT, Boston University, and other stakeholders since the last public meeting for this project in June of 2019
- The project was included in the presentation at each of the five (5) GLT public meetings in September 2019

# **Construction Procurement**

- Project advertisement: February 13, 2020
- Engineer's Estimate: \$15,372,802
- Bid opening: March 12, 2020
- Two (2) bids received:

\$ 17,768,400	MAS Building and Bridge (Low Bidder)
\$ 18,143,000	Barletta Heavy Division

A bid analysis has be completed and **MAS Building and Bridge** is the recommended low responsible bidder

### **Request of the Fiscal and Management Control Board**

Staff request that the Fiscal and Management Control Board authorize the MBTA General Manager, or his designee, to award and execute MBTA Construction Contract No. A25CN01: Green Line B-Branch Station Consolidation And Accessibility Improvements with **MAS Building and Bridge** for an amount not to exceed \$17,768,400.
