

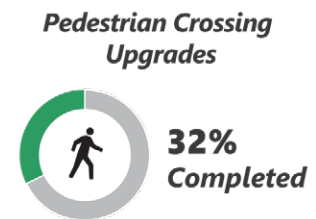
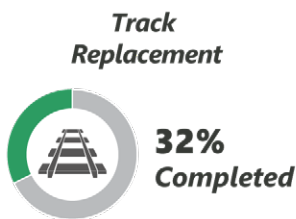
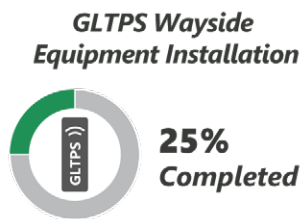
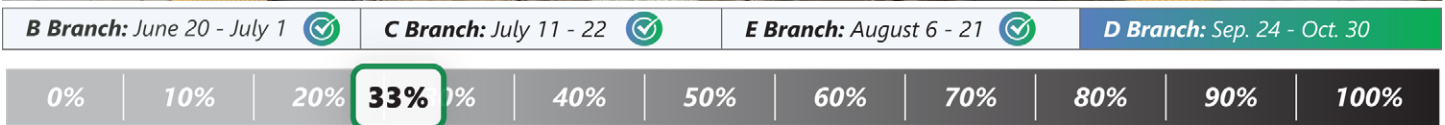
Week in Review and Lookahead

Friday, October 7, 2022

After the successful completion of our first full access closure on the D Branch, work will resume this weekend. From Saturday, October 8 – Sunday, October 16, crews will replace track and upgrade pedestrian crossings at Waban Station, while GLTPS equipment installation continues along the branch.



Green Line Train Protection and Track Upgrades



Green Line Train Protection and Track Upgrades: From June through October, we'll complete over 10,000 feet of track upgrades on the B, C, D, and E branches alongside work on the Green Line Train Protection System (GLTPS)

- ✓ **This Week** | Crews completed work around Woodland Station this past Sunday, October 2 and D Branch service resumed on Monday, October 3
- **Lookahead** | The second D Branch full access closure will take place from Saturday, October 8 to Sunday, October 16. Crews will replace 2,000 feet of rail and upgrade two pedestrian crossings at Waban Station, while installation of GLTPS equipment continues

- ✓ **This Week** | In collaboration with the Town of Brookline, crews began upgrading several pedestrian crossings along Beacon Street on the C Branch. Work began on the Hawes Street crossing and upgrades were completed on the Carlton Street crossing
- **Lookahead** | Work on the Hawes Street crossing will continue next week, and construction will begin on the St. Paul Street crossing
