



 - Move the slider to adjust the caption size














Project Overview

- Full Station Reconstruction:
 - Two new fully accessible, high-level, side platforms with canopies.
 - Three new elevators, two new ramps and three sets of covered stairs.
 - New lighting, signage and wayfinding security cameras, and other amenities.
 - New tracks, ties, ballast, bridge plates and communication duct banks.
- Total Construction Cost: \$50 Million



 - Working on the South End and moving North
 - Neighbors can expect continued noise from construction activity including heavy equipment and machinery

- Construction advisories will be distributed ahead of any scheduled night or weekend work, if necessary
