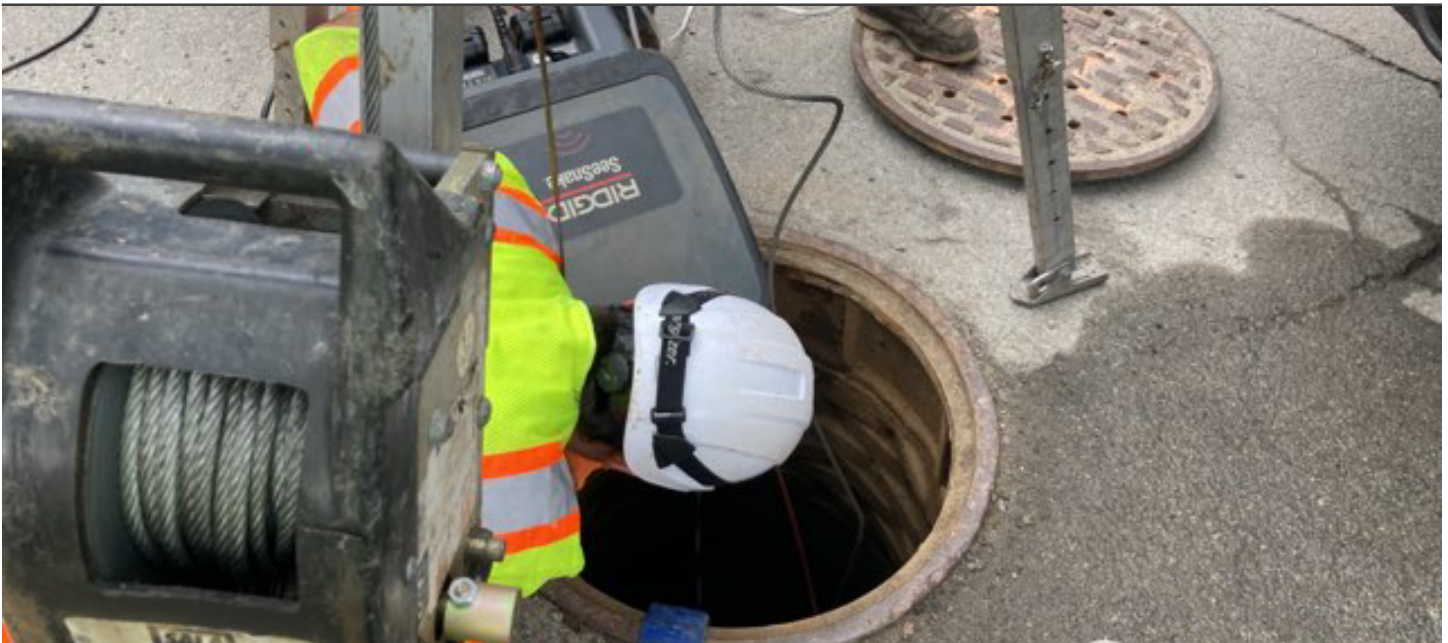
Codman Yard Expansion and Improvements

- ✓ **This Week** | Crews installed precast utility vaults, reinforcing steel and concrete for the traction power ductbanks to provide a protected pathway for underground electrical conduit from the substation to the electrified third rail
- **Lookahead** | Crews will continue to excavate trenches for installation of traction power ductbanks and install utility vaults under the new train storage tracks
