






Today's presentation will provide background information on procuring contracted construction services for **Emergency Track Improvement** – **Red Line** through MBTA Contract No. T90CN07, which will consist of track rehabilitation to support the MBTA in addressing speed restrictions and state of good repair on the Red Line, thereby increasing the MBTA's ability to provide a safe and reliable trip and improve the overall quality of service.







Improved Quality of Service

Construction of the Contract

- Construction Procurement proactively contacted track contractors (both inside and outside of Massachusetts) to understand their reluctance to bid on track On-Call contracts
- Contract packaged to increase competition by:
 - Packaging defined scope by lines
 - Providing pre-planned continuous access over a period of time
- Pre-bid activities
 - Pre-bid bus tour of track pads for access
 - Schematics and videos of track made available
- Included Incentive and Disincentive Language



Construction Procurement

- Project advertisement: February 07, 2024
- Bid opening: March 7, 2024
- DBE Goal: **5**%
- Three prequalified and eligible bidders:
 - The Middlesex Corporation
 - Railroad-SPS New England, a Joint Venture
 - Skanska Delta, Joint Venture
