-On Sundays, July 14, Train 2200 (5:35 am from Haverhill) & Train 2201 (7:00 am from North Station) will operate as intended and make all stops between Haverhill/Bradford & North Station.

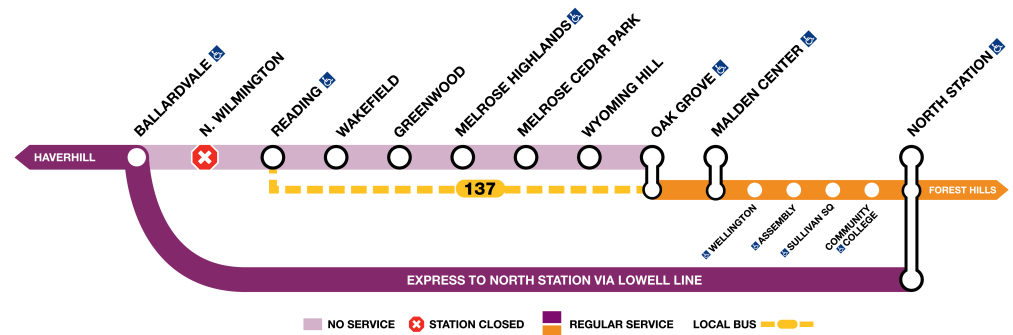
-Regular train service will resume after 7 pm on both days of both weekends.
